## International Collaboration Team

The International Collaboration Team has strived to give students an international perspective by collaborating with several overseas organizations to promote cultural learning for our students. Rather than learning about other cultures from books only, they can actually come in contact with a living, breathing part of that culture; needless to say, the effect is profound.



On December 18th, 2007, our school was visited by a group of delegates from Dhaka, Bangladesh. Our students had a chance to interact with these friendly guests and learn about Bangladesh as a country through cultural sharing activities in specially selected English classes, at the IH Corner, and finally at the watercolour painting workshop with Mr. Jarbeb Rashel, who is an accomplished painter. Our guests, all of whom are well-accomplished in their respective fields (ie. communication engineers, manager for a Rock-and-Roll band, radio DJ, etc) were also able to give career advice to our students. Throughout the day, our students basked in the Bangladeshi experience through dancing, singing, presentations, and special campus radio live interview with the guests. It was truly a valuable experience.

On March 7th, we received Yuk Choi Middle School from Malaysia for a friendly soccer game. Being a Christian school themselves, they were also entertained by our SPKC Student Fellowship.



On the 28th of May, our B-grade basketball team got on their feet and hiked down the hill to visit one of our friendly neighborhood international schools; the International Christian School (ICS). Our students engaged in a fiercely competitive yet friendly basketball game with the ICS basketball team; Although our team lost, our fighting spirit was seen even by our opponents; it was a proud moment for our students.

## 十架之愛 念記中國四川地震同胞 周慧儀老師

零八年五月十二日二時二十八分，地動山搖，河水漲湧，禍患臨至，公路破裂，學校倒塌，樓房毀掉，滿地頹垣敗瓦，人只有慌忙逃亂。瓦礫下傳來呼求，瓦礫壓著截肢；生靈在哀慟，流淚、嚎哭、茫然。世上的天災人禍有時像不太實在，人生的悲喜離合有時更出乎意外。扭曲遺容似乎烙印著傷痕與絕望；蒼生的淚水卻倒影著人間的關愛。

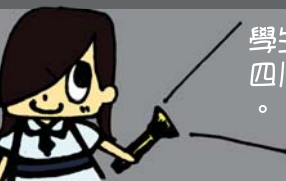
## 苦難Q & A

文見歡傳道

苦難問題從來都不易解答，因為一次災難的發生所牽涉的因素很多，天災與人禍的關係千絲萬縷，互相影響。誠然，答了苦難問題並不會減少受苦者的哀痛。但若為了堅固信仰，以下淺釋可作為參考。

Q：神容許四川地震發生，多人傷亡，這是神的旨意嗎？

A：不是！若每一件事情的發生都推算為得神容許，再推論是神的旨意，這推論是武斷的！例如我不能說我成功抄了功課便推論抄功課是神的旨意，因為聖經已明言了「誠實」這大原則，所以與誠實有抵觸的抄功課絕不是神的心意。同樣，聖經多處表明上帝不想有人無辜死亡（出25:7；申19:10；箴6:17），祂重視每一個人的生命。所以這次多人無辜死亡絕不是神的旨意，也不是天譴或管教。至於是否必定要找出一個意義才可助人去面對此苦難，則不盡然。

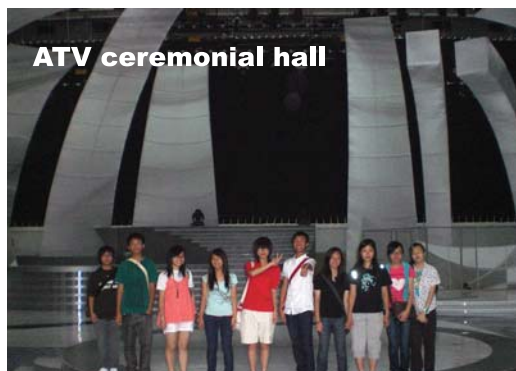
# SPKC Radio

# Library News

2007-2008 has been another year of success for the SPKC Library, with more than 1,500 new books on the shelves, a more established student librarian system, and the highest library usage ever recorded in SPKC. Thanks to the continuous effort and tremendous enthusiasm of our teachers, Mr. Ether Ho, Mr. Ken Ko, Miss Man Yan Cheng, and Miss Joanie Yeung, a series of class-based book sharing sessions has run successfully from October to June in morning assemblies. Each class had a chance to share with the whole school their favourite English books. An ongoing reading scheme for both Chinese and English books has also recorded a total of 9,000 books being borrowed and read by SPKC students this year. To cultivate Christian values among students, a special effort has also been made to enlarge our Christian and devotional book collection (now more than 200 books).

Parent helpers have contributed tremendously in the processing of the books and getting them ready quickly for student access. We have a total of 45 parent helpers this year! Without their participation, new books would not have found their way to the students' hands at such an incredible speed. Special thanks also go to our student librarians, in particular our five group leaders, who have dedicated their time to serving schoolmates and teachers.
