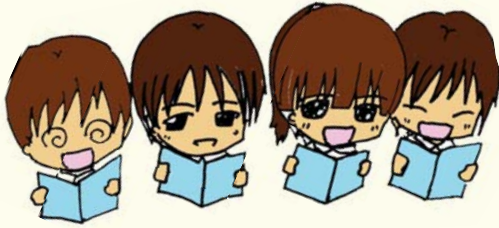
編者的話

Principal's Message

Rethinking the School's Mission

Five years ago, our school was founded, with a mission of preparing "Leaders of tomorrow". I believe that you should all know our school's mission: "We aim at preparing tomorrow's leaders with character and intelligence."

What is exactly meant by "Leaders of tomorrow"?

After rethinking the mission of our school, the needs of the adolescents, the development of the school and the world in the future, I would like to share with you what the essential qualities of tomorrow's leaders are.

1. High Self-esteem (自重自愛)

Leaders have a positive self-concept. They can recognize their strengths and bring them into full play. They can identify their limitations and overcome them or accept them if they are unchangeable. They are well aware that they are worthy not because of what they own or what they do, but because they are made in the image of God.

2. Love and Care (關懷愛顧)

Leaders demonstrate a harmonious relationship with others; no matter if they are friends or someone different from them in certain aspects. They are ready to share and be assertive to settle conflicts in a rational and peaceful way. To serve others is always their priority because they may empathize with the people in need and they really care.

3. Globalized Vision (全球視野)

knowledge, ability and attitude to either collaborate or compete with the people all over the world. English Language, Putonghua, Chinese Language, IT technology are the tools they should master effectively.

4. Life-long Learning (終身學習)

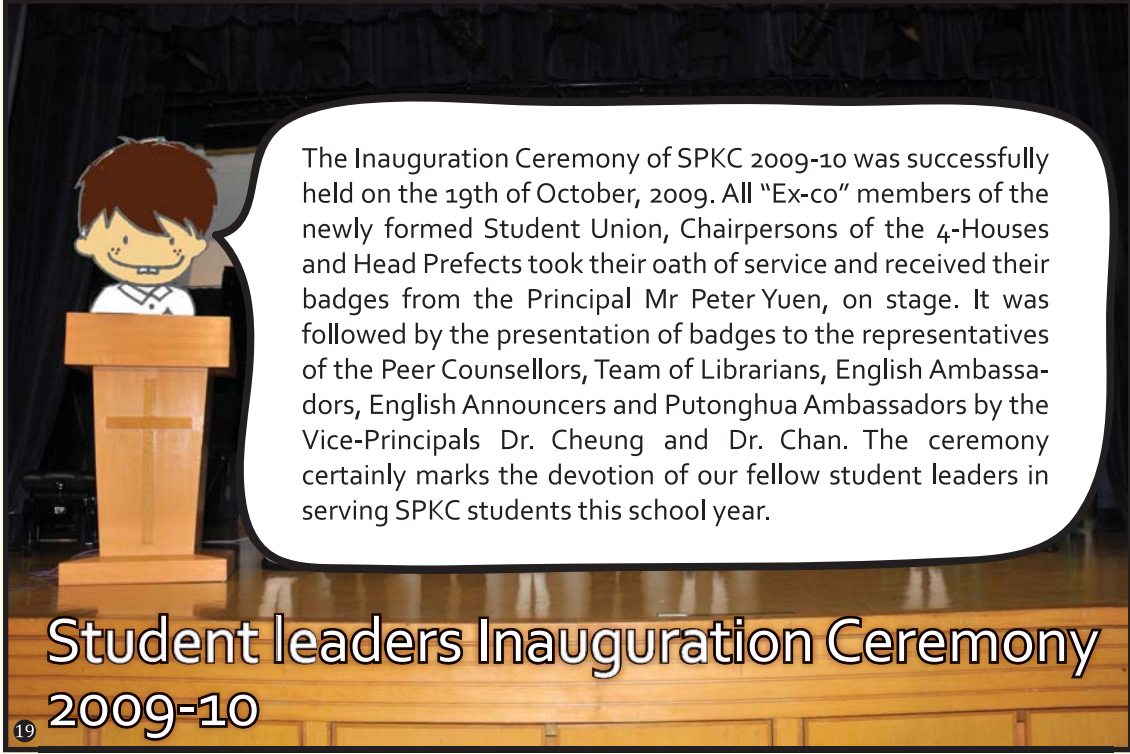

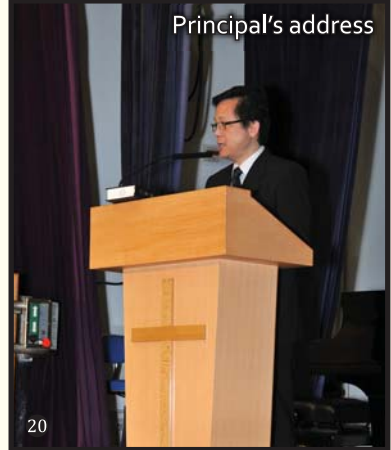

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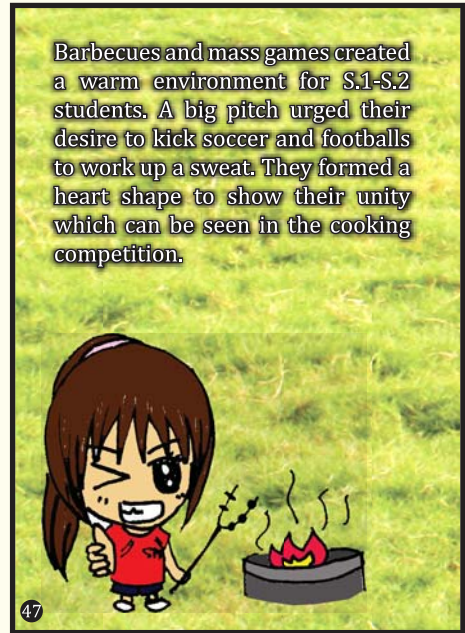

CLASS MINI-BOARD COMPETITION (30-9-2009)

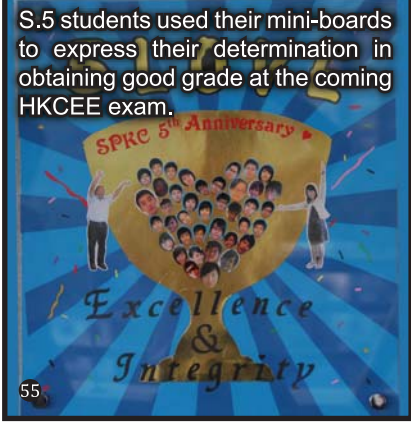
