This year, 12 students proudly represented SPKC College in the Hong Kong Schools Mock Trial Competition. They faced fierce opposition against elite schools such as Sing Yin Secondary School, Yuen Long Merchants' School and St. Stephen's Girls' College. However, all students worked well together reading, researching and writing about real life legal principles by preparing research reports, and memorandums of advice. However the highlight for most students came through practicing skills of oral advocacy in tense and dramatic court room battles as they portrayed the roles of prosecuting lawyers, defence counsel, witnesses, defendants and victims.

With the help of Teacher in Charge Ms Jessica Au Yeung (English Teacher), Coach and Advisor Mr Stephen Marson (NET and Literature Teacher), Alumni Mr Dennis

Ng (LLB Undergraduate), Senior Student Angel Lam (Best Lawyer of the Trial 2011) and Advising Solicitor (Mr Kay Chan), students were elated to advance successfully to the second round of the competition. Although great team work was always evident, a number of students were singled out for exceptional praise with Joey Wong, Rammi Chui, Pansy Kwan and Kathleen Wan winning awards and prizes for best Lawyer of the Trial and Best Witness of the Trial.
