Counting blessings: A special Friday worship was held during the week. One student was selected from each S6 class to share their testimony in SPKC.




Worship: On Wednesday, the school Worship Team led worship during lunch time.

Drama is gaining popularity and demand in Hong Kong Schools. Drama engages and complements language learning through games, strategies and activities. These enhance teamwork, confidence in expression, spontaneous English usage, and dramatic play. Drama provides students with a chance to develop and practise spoken English with confidence and in a fun and engaging way. It draws students' focus to other kinesthetic skills of expression through gestures and body language.

SPKC's first Drama Club took off this year with a bang. There was a healthy mix of junior and senior form students who enrolled in the club. It was a combination of curiosity, enthusiasm and a growing interest for drama that motivated them to sign-up for this club. An outing to the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts was organized early in the year. 20 students and 5 teachers enjoyed a professional theatre production, 'The Complete Works of William Shakespeare' performed by The Reduced Shakespeare Company last October.
