
Striving for Academic Excellence in Public Examinations 公開考試 追求卓越

Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) Results (2013) 2013年香港中學文憑考試成績

The result of the HKDSE Examination (2013) was encouraging and showing continued improvement. The overall subject pass rate was 95.5% while the percentage of attaining Level 4 or above was 41.9%. The pass rates of the 4 core subjects were all above the average in H.K.: English Language (100% vs 77.8%), Chinese Language (93% vs 80.7%), Mathematics (97.9% vs 80.8%) and Liberal Studies (95.9% vs 88.5%).

本校2013年度DSE成績頗為理想,整體合格率為95.5%,成績等級四級或以上的比率為41.9%。四科主要科目及格率均超越全港平均成績(英文科100%;中文科93%;數學科97.9%;通識科95.9%,而全港平均數據則分別為77.8%/80.7%/80.8%/88.%)。

As an EMI school, SPKC provides our students with quality English Language education aimed at the enhancement of students' proficiency in English whereby they can become effective communicators in this medium for our modern world.

We believe that enhancing teaching quality and effectiveness in English learning inside and outside the classroom is of the upmost importance in consolidating the language foundation and cultivating the learning environment. The small class teaching policy in our school has enabled our teachers to cater for learner diversity and maximize students' potential. Through the implementation of the Literature in English programme, Drama Education, Book Appreciation Award Scheme and the support of NETs, students are able to enhance their proficiency for internal and external exams as well as for their lives and careers. Senior Form students are also given opportunities to take Cambridge University IGCSE English 'O' level and have IELTS examination preparation.

We are able to provide students with numerous opportunities to use, appreciate and explore English in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere through a variety of activities organized by the English Department. The establishment of English Zone with interesting resource materials has successfully created a comfortable environment for Self-Access Learning, at the same time providing activities with explicit links to classroom learning. We endeavour to promote the use of English integrated into our daily school life and an English learning environment using daily English Announcers in morning assembly, broadcasts of SPKC Radio, the English Newspaper "Express", English Speaking Days twice a week and a range of other learning experiences. In order to widen students' opportunities, we provide maximum English exposure as well as meaningful and purposeful activities outside school. We encourage students to participate in different activities out of school such as inter-school regional and national competitions, the Speech Festival, NESTA SCMP Debating, Sing Tao Debating competitions, Mock Trial Competitions, Joint Schools Oral Practice, and the Hong Kong School English Drama Festival.

In addition, we also understand that knowledge should not be limited by subjects, but should be complementary to each subject. Therefore we have attempted to broaden students' perspectives and develop skills for life-long learning by fostering greater coherence between English Language and the other subjects such as Integrated Humanities (IH), Mathematics, Music and Art through cross-curricular collaboration.

As an EMI school, English is the foundation and rationale of SPKC's academic programme. It is essential for the development of an international perspective and life-long learning.

本校英文科讓學生在多元化的活動中,輕鬆地掌握英文。特設的「英語角」備有大量有趣教材,讓學生愉快、輕鬆地自學,也能與常規課堂互補,加強教學效果。我們更透過學生英語報告員、校園電台、英文學生報 "Express"、每週兩天的全校英語日等,致力營造一個英語校園環境。為擴闊學生視野,我們亦鼓勵學生參與校際 地區及全國性比賽和活動、如英語辯論節、NESTA-SCMP英語辯論賽、星島辯論賽、模擬法庭比賽、聯校口語溝通訓練,以及香港學校戲劇節等等。

除此以外,我們提倡跨課程的學習,透過與綜合人文、數學、音樂、視藝等科目協作,增廣學生見聞,培養其終身學習的習慣。

對於一所以英語授課中學而言,英語教學正是學生終身學習、培養國際視野以及提昇學術水平的基礎。

International Perspective in SPKC 培育國際視野

In order to broaden our student's horizons, and to encourage them to adopt a global vision and international perspectives, SPKC is devoted to cultivating intercultural awareness and sound understanding of various world issues. This is developed and promoted through a wide range of initiatives, activities and learning opportunities throughout the year. Through our sister-school exchange schemes, Learning Without Walls (LEWOWA), and participation in international projects with local and overseas schools, SPKC students have access to a global and multicultural network of education communities to explore global issues and cultural diversity first-hand.

On campus, International Awareness Week and Intercultural Forums are held to invite students and members of different local communities to engage in sharing about world needs. In previous years SPKC has held video conferences with schools from 14 different countries. These projects have also included collaborative music composition, digital storytelling video production, intercultural forums, Mandarin debates and English book review conferences.

SPKC has sent teams to participate in two Model United Nations conferences as representative delegates of Brazil, South Africa, and Saudi Arabia. In safeguarding the interests of the Third World in some of the most critical and controversial global issues, our delegates sought to reach peaceful compromises and mutual understanding that are so desperately needed in our world today.

A highlight of the year for many students is of course the LEWOWA program. Students from our school have travelled to far off places such as Switzerland, Germany, England, USA, Australia, France and to shorter distance trips nearer to Hong Kong. This provided students with unique and valuable opportunities to not only learn about but to also see, hear, taste and interact with all that these unique places have to offer. It is a unique, exciting, and exhilarating experience for all students and teachers alike. We are also now part of the AFS student exchange programme and have hosted students from Italy and Holland whilst some SPKC students have also spent an academic year in Norway and Italy.

本校每年舉辦「國際關懷週」和「文化論壇」,邀請國際學校的學生來本 校參與文化交流活動,彼此分享和學習。本校每年亦積極與世界各地的學校 安排多次視像會議,讓學生與來自不同文化背景的朋輩交流。本校透過視像會 議交流的國家已達十四個,內容包括作曲、數碼故事創作、文化論壇、普通話辯 論及英文書會等。

此外,本校也派出代表隊伍參加模擬聯合國會議,曾代表的國家包括 巴西、南非及沙地阿拉伯。身為這些國家的大使,學生積極為第三世界的 利益辯護,亦在不同具爭議性的國際議題上與各國代表談判,尋求和平解 決的方案,當中的合作精神和溝通技巧正是現今普世極其需要的。

作為本校的重點課程,「學習無疆界」為學生提供寶貴的課室外學習體 驗,學生的足跡遠達英、美、德法、澳洲、瑞士以及亞洲各地區。這種獨 特難忘的體驗不但令學生增廣見聞,更提升了他們的學習興趣。學生積極 參與課程,認真學習的態度更令人鼓舞。

Our school has been blessed with a group of warm-hearted and devoted Christians, some of these teachers have been charged with the mission of spreading the word of God and leading those students who are already Christians. This team, aptly named, the "Christian Education Team" is led by our school Chaplain, and was created with close ties with the C&MA Abundant Grace Church in-school Pastors and BREAKTHROUGH. The Team seeks to lead our students in finding the truth, committing to the faith, and becoming passionate about serving the community through the Personal-Social-Spiritual Education curriculum and various other activities such as fellowship, spiritual reading scheme, discipleship training, leading of school-wide prayers during the morning assembly, gospel week, development camp, Gospel basketball and soccer teams.

Moral and Civic Education 德育及公民教育

We believe every SPKC student possesses intelligence and virtue. They can glorify God and serve others. To achieve these goals, clear developmental goals are set for each form including self-management and confidence (S.1), Harmony and Diligence (S.2), Initiative and Competence (S.3), Responsibility and Serving Heart (S.4), Vision and Perseverance (S.5) and Excellence and Integrity (S.6).

We seek to cultivate our students with these characteristics. This is done through activities like Poverty Week, Love Ambassador Programme, Green Ambassador Programme, current affairs forums, student leaders' election, Civic Education talks, health education workshops and variety of adventure-based training programmes.

Our students are also keen on performing voluntary service. We have joined the "Heart to Heart School" programme organized by the Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups to motivate our students to actively participate in the community and school services, we were awarded the "Caring School Award" from HK Christian Service

last year. In addition to Rotary Interact Club, Red Cross and Boy Scout, all students are also required to participate in community services, including Flag Selling activities, charity walkathons, and elderly home visitation.

本校學生亦樂於參與義工服務。我們多次參與了由香港青年協會舉辦之「有心學校」計劃,以鼓勵學生主動參與學校及社區服務,去年更在香港基督教服務處舉辦之「關愛校園獎勵計劃」中獲獎。本校除設有扶輪青年服務團、「義工力量」學會、紅十字會與童軍等組織外,所有學生均須參與不同的社區服務,包括賣旗活動、步行籌款、老人探訪等等。

SPKC offers different combinations of subjects for students to choose from the new NSS Curriculum. Apart from Chinese, English, Mathematics, Liberal Studies and "Other Learning Experiences", students can choose 2 to 3 more electives according to their preference.

This allows students to choose the subjects they like with more flexibility.

In order to meet the requirement of "Other Learning Experiences" in the NSS Curriculum and at the same time promote students' whole-person development, our school has taken into consideration different kinds of elements when we designed and prepared for the new curriculum, such as Moral and Civic Education, Community Service, Religious Studies, Physical Education, and Aesthetic Development.

Under 3-3-4, Liberal Studies is a compulsory subject. To help students better understand this subject and to enhance both teaching and learning effectiveness, we have adopted different teaching strategies and activities, such as small-class teaching, lectures, workshops, in-class discussions, lesson observations and sharing as well as outdoor excursions.

eCampus@SPKC電子校園@培基

The concept of eCampus@SPKC introduced in 2012 includes eLearning, eAdministration, multimedia and interactive interface, and school IT infrastructure which interconnects with Pooikeian (students, teachers and parents) and public.

Our campus is equipped with fast wireless and Ethernet network (10 Gigabit Ethernet) which facilitates school based E-learning development and teaching strategies.

Teachers have started using tablets to deliver knowledge in a more efficient way. And, the effectiveness of students centered learning will be enhanced by introducing different application software (Apps) in lessons. For instance, a statistical report is generated after students answer the questions, teachers mark students' work and give feedback instantly in class. Furthermore, with i-cloud technology, our students can have self-study anywhere after lessons.

An eAdministration system has been implemented where students use their smart cards for attendance taking, borrowing library books and campus access. Parents can check and sign school notices and pay miscellaneous fees electronically.

For the interactive interface, our new school webpage provides a platform to update all Pooikeians and the public with the latest news and information about SPKC.

Multimedia (Campus TV and SPKC Radio) is also a part of our eCampus. Campus TV has been set up in SPKC in order to put this power of information into the hands of a group of capable and enthusiastic students. By providing students with training in areas such as camera work, editing and presentation skills, we are building our own professional television crew. In return, students are given real-world training that can prepare them for their further education as well as future occupations. Also, students can enjoy the Campus TV programmes and receive important information through the Campus Electronic Bulletin Board system everywhere.

SPKC Radio has an enthusiastic team drawn from all year levels which broadcasts twice a week on a range of interest topics in its lunchtime programmes.

本校的行政系統已經開始電子化,學生可使用一張智能卡簽到、借閱圖書和出入特 定區域。家長亦可於網上查閱及簽署通告,更可以網上繳交學校雜費。

學校網頁提供了一個消息發放的互動平台,讓人們了解本校最新情況。

多媒體廣播(校園電視台及校園電台)也是我們電子校園的一部份。校園電視台的成立,把傳遞資訊和知識這項重要任務交到學生手中。透過攝像工作、編輯技巧、表達能力等培訓,我們不但建立了一個專業的學校電視隊伍,而且學生更能透過這些實務訓練,為其將來的持續學習奠定基礎。此外,透過偏佈校園的電子告示板網絡,學生亦可隨時隨地觀看校園電視節目,以及接收重要資訊。

校園電台為各級有志於製作節目的學生所組成,每星期兩次於午飯時段播放多元化的錄音節目。

Student Financial Assistance and Scholarship Scheme (SFASS) 學生獎助學金計劃

The SPKC Student Financial Assistance and Scholarship Scheme is set up to support families with financial needs or students with outstanding performance, either in academic or non-academic aspects. It includes School-based Financial Assistance Scheme, and a SPKC Scholarship Scheme. A total amount of about two million dollars, 10% of total tuition fees, will be budgeted for this purpose every academic year.

Highlight of SFASS 獎助學金計劃舉隅:

 - It aims at providing financial assistance to eligible students to receive secondary education in SPKC. Students in unexpected financial need may also apply for the fee remission. All students are promised that financial difficulties should NOT be a problem for them to continue their studying in SPKC.

 - This is the most prestigious academic award in SPKC which aims to recognize the excellent public exam result obtained by our top student. A full grant of 1st year tuition fee for the student admitted to an undergraduate degree programme will be awarded. The maximum value of this scholarship is equivalent to the annual local university tuition (about HK\$42,000).
