





The song debuted at number 97 on the Billboard Hot 100, but its strong digital sales have propelled it to the number-one position for the issue dated November 7, 2009 and back for the issue dated November 21, 2009. It also has currently sold 1,574,678 downloads. It has reached number two on the Canadian Hot 100 and went to number one on the Canadian Digital Songs chart. Owl City have also had the track "Fireflies" featured on newly released Tap Tap Revenge 3 application for the iPod Touch and iPhone. In an interview with PopEater, Kesha further elaborated saying: 'I just really wanted to embody the lifestyle that I live, "We're all young and broke and it doesn't matter. Todd Martens of the Los Angeles Times called the reference "the cut's biggest oddity".






Times Square is a big shopping mall in Causeway Bay, Hong Kong.

Thierry Henry's handball puts goal line

referees on Fifa's World Cup agenda

France qualified for its fourth consecutive. World Cup when officials missed an obvious hand ball by Thierry Henry that led to William Gallas' overtime goal in a 1-1 tie against Ireland on Wednesday night.

elevision footage of Wednesday's match, eight minutes into extra time, shows that Henry twice handled the ball in the box to keep it in play, before a short tap allowed William Gallas to score. Though Ireland are widely held to have played better, the goal put France 2-1 ahead on aggregate, sealing qualification for the French – and a national tragedy for the Irish.

A furious Football Association of Ireland lodged a formal complaint over Swedish referee Martin Hansson's decision to allow the goal. Chief executive, John Delaney, said: "I really believe the integrity of the game has been questioned last night."

Irish people's hearts are broken. They were so close to the World Cup finals but "Henry's handball" at the last minute had destroyed their hopes.

Thierry Henry is the captain of France. In this recent decisive match, he used his hand to help France score the goal that gave them an aggregate victory.

At that time, the referee and his assistants did not spot the infraction. But Henry's hand could not escape from the camera lens. Through slow-motion animations, he was seen passing the ball with his hand. Clearly, it was an infraction. Even the France team and Henry admitted that it was a handball. However, the referee's decision was made and the game ended.

It does not relate only to Ireland or it is not merely a soccer issue. Instead, it is a universal debate on the contradiction between the rules of games and fairness.

France has qualified for the 2010 World Cup while the Republic of Ireland is eliminated. The team which had done something was rewarded while the team which had done nothing wrong was punished. The soccer spirit of fairness had been destroyed. In the future, instead of using their feet, soccer players may just use all kinds of tricks and cheat - as long as the referee cannot notice them

In addition to player's qualities and team strategies, how to win with unfair tactics would be another way to success.
